BISHOP TO OPEN MATTITUCK SATELLITE OFFICE

Congressman to Host Open House at Mattituck Office

Mattituck—Congressman Tim Bishop (D-Southampton) is inviting the public to join him Monday, March 24, at 4:30pm for the grand opening of his satellite office in Mattituck. The office is located at the Southold Town Human Resource Center at 750 Pacific Street in Mattituck. Bishop will be available to meet with constituents at the Open House. Southold Supervisor Josh Horton who was vital in securing the office's location will be at the event as well.

“One of the most important parts of my job as Congressman is helping district residents who need assistance with federal problems or concerns,” Bishop said. “I invite constituents to stop by the Open House and please say hello, but more importantly, I hope people will contact my office if they need help dealing with a government agency.”

Below are some of the types of situations which the Congressman works with on a regular basis:

- Social Security questions about benefits, disabilities, or a lost check.
- Immigration questions regarding citizenship, permanent residency, or form requests.
- U.S. Postal Service problems.
- Internal Revenue Service problems.
- Medicare billing problems that are incorrect or not understood.
- Veterans issues, including procedures, records, or medals.
- Problems with Federal Employees' Workers Compensation.
